Verity House is a Ofsted rated good children's residential that provides a family-like atmosphere for up to four children and young people aged 7 to 17 who face emotional and behavioural challenges, learning differences, or identify as neurodiverse. We offer a safe and nurturing environment that embraces diversity while prioritising individual needs. We collaborate with families and professionals to create tailored support plans, ensuring that each child's specific requirements are met.

Accommodation

Verity House is designed to offer a warm, caring, and inclusive and beautiful home environment where all children feel welcomed, regardless of cultural background, race, sexuality, or age. Our dedicated staff are available 24/7, including two overnight caregivers to provide additional support as needed. Our support extends through regular engagement, as children receive important information about our practices upon admission and are continuously consulted during their stay.

Our Unique Approach

At Verity House, we empower children and young people to make choices while providing a safe environment for exploration. We focus on positive reinforcement to boost self-esteem and encourage responsible decision-making. Our tailored PACE approach considers each child's unique strengths and challenges, enabling a supportive atmosphere where they can thrive. We prioritise matching new admissions with existing young people to enhance group dynamics and provide a cohesive living experience. We aim to ensure that each child receives the ongoing support they require as they transition to future placements, this includes stepping down into fostering following support from our team.
